Thunder Bay-based Premier Gold Mines Ltd. is excited about its gold mining prospects in the region.

Investor relations spokesman Matt Gollat said in a press release Thursday that the company "is spearheading an incredible exploration program" in Canada and Mexico, with nine diamond drills currently turning.

"We have had some exciting and interesting events unfold (recently)," he said.

The company is a spinoff of former Wolfden Resources and is run by the same CEO, Ewan Downie.

Gold properties currently being explored include:

Rahill-Bonanza Project in Red Lake (a joint venture with Goldcorp Inc.), where drills are targeting deep sections along strike from the Red Lake Gold Mine, Wilmar Gold Mine and Bonanza deposit.

PQ North Project, located adjacent to Goldcorp's Musselwhite Mine north of Pickle Lake, which contains a major zone of quartz veining associated with a major "break" that remains untested.

Geraldton Project, which is located in the heart of the Beardmore-Geraldton greenstone belt, a highly prospective high-grade gold district that has seen relatively little exploration over the past several decades.

The property holds huge potential, with discoveries made on the first three targets tested, with more results expected in the near future, the company says.

Santa Teresa, Mexico, where multiple high-grade veins have been discovered along strike from the historic Princessa Gold Mine.
